Abstract: Republic of Kosovo in the last 3-4 years has improved the road infrastructure, among others, by improving conditions for the needs of citizens of the country and by meeting the requirements of international organizations who are seeking with the right that the region of South-East to have the performance equivalent to EU standards. Section Pristina-Skopje of Route 6 represents one of the most important sections of this road going through important parts of the country and enabling direct links to key routes and corridors in South East.
